



Help Grand View recycle responsibly

Items that are NOT RECYCLABLE at our facility

Single Use plastic bags
Sheets of plastic
Bread, garbage or sandwich bags, etc.
Bubble Wrap
Packing Peanuts – check to see if yours dissolve in water
Styrofoam – check for symbol
Hard plastic parts – unless marked
Toys – unless marked
Used paper plates
Plastic knives, spoons or forks
Batteries – Hearing aid, AAA, AA, etc.
Fluorescent bulbs – needs to go to a hazardous waste disposal
Mercury bulbs – needs to go to a hazardous waste disposal
Oil based paints, solvents or thinners
Oil, gasoline, hydraulic fluid and their containers
Plastic pet food bags

Other ways to help recycle responsibly

1. Loose load you recycling – do not put in a plastic bag
2. Check recyclable items for food or liquid before adding to the dumpster
3. Make sure the recyclable items are clean and dry
4. At the recycling dumpster, empty the recyclable items directly into the dumpster
5. Take back, dispose of in the trash any container used for hauling your recyclable items to the dumpster.
