Town Board Meeting Wednesday September 9, 2020

Present: Chairman Iverson, Supervisors Bonk and Oravis. Clerk Gunderson, Treasurer Mottram and 4 others.

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Iverson at 7:00 p.m. Minutes of August 12th read. Motion O/B to approve. Carried. Financial Report - Motion B/O. Carried.

OLD BUSINESS: None

REPORTS: Work done on 18 Mile Bridge on S Sweden, and 2 culverts each placed on Ryan's Lane, N Diamond Lake and S. Sweden. Expect gravel crushing in the 1st 2 weeks of October. Pits have been stripped and are ready to go. In the past the stripping and movement of gravel at pits was done by the gravel crusher. The low bid we accepted for this will not be doing that work.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Library Book Boxes - these would require someone to build and stock. Will check into.

Dust Abatement – Jim Wysocki said it is time to put this together and implement. He thinks the town needs to put some gravel down now and that the belly blade is useless. Said the crew needs to pay attention so they don't create potholes, etc. Club Lake Rd is on the list to have holes filled along with Pioneer Rd, S. Sweden and Campground Rd. Forestry does not want calcium chloride so close to the lake. Recycled blacktop is prone for potholes and scaling. Maybe putting down some type of oil or fuel, but then you can't grade it so not sure what the answer is. Hollard Millar called the County Sheriff's Dept. on the Town Crew. We will need to call the Sheriff's Dept. if our crew is gone after again! This has got to stop!

Speed limits for ATV/UTV's – Dane spoke with DOT and while it is legal to set speed limits, they don't recommend having two different speed limits as it can cause more problems than it solves. Dane has left a message for the County. This portion of Old Grade Road is not listed to be studied as there have not been enough problems to date. The signs we have right now are not legal and if anyone complained we would not win the speed limit debate!

NEW BUSINESS: Comprehensive Zoning Plan – the Committee Chairman is dealing with some health issues. May want to set up a meeting with the Board, Committee and Karl Kastrosky – Will set up first meeting for September 23 at 7:30.

5-year Policy – maybe come up with plan for next year. Outlet cover on Trappers Lake would be one project. Should come up with other major projects. No Action.

We need to come up with a plan for LRIP (\$23,000.00). Jack will meet with Mark and Kenny.

Towns Association meeting – would have been this month at Lakewoods. We can join online meetings on September 14^{th} and 28^{th} (or 15^{th} and 29^{th}).
