

Town Board Meeting
Wednesday August 11, 2021

Present: Chairman Iverson, Supervisors Ahlvin and Swanson, Clerk Gunderson, Treasurer Mottram and 4 others.

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Iverson at 7:00 p.m. Minutes of July 14th read. Motion Swanson/Ahlvin to approve. Carried. Financial Report - Motion Swanson/Ahlvin. Carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Mike Jacobs was here thank the Board for putting up an ATV/UTV End Route sign.

Dan Arens came before the board to question why none of the local contractors were notified about the roofing projects the Town is having done along with the Pole Building Bid that is now out. 'Why would you go to Ashland and Duluth instead of contracting locally?' Jack apologized for this oversight. Teresa will try to put together a list of local contractors to contact when we have projects in the Town going forward. Dale will get a set of specs for the Pole Building to Dan tomorrow (August 12th) for the bid opening of August 18th. Dale stated that the museum, storage shed and Town Hall roofing projects should start in about 2 weeks. Pete's is waiting for the metal to come in.

NEW BUSINESS: Grand View Rec. – President Jake Kinnunen – presented plans for a new concession stand along with a wish list for upgrades to the Ballpark. The concession stand would replace the existing bathrooms and metal storage building – see attached. They will start looking into grants and the board will look at putting this into next year's budget. Jake also presented the Financial Report for this year to date. There has been a lot more activity and they have done better this year. They will be purchasing 2 loads of Aglime for the softball and baseball field to place yet this year.

ARPA – Grand View is eligible for \$48,000.00 over two years. Received request for Great Divide Ambulance. Could also look at Fire Dept., Sewer or Rec as well. There are a lot of restrictions so will have to do more checking.

Delmore Contract – received a contract for culvert inventory – No Action.

Would like to sit down with road crew to work on LRIP and 5-year plan. Jason was hoping Mark would submit his ideas but Jack felt it would be better to do in person. WE should also look at Mark providing a road report for each meeting. Will try to set up a work meeting in the next week or two.

Request for CCC (Senior Citizens Café) to have a meeting on September 7th to discuss what they can do about having the CCC again. Their meeting at 12:00 on the 7th is fine with the Board.

Motion Swanson/Ahlvin to adjourn at 8:30 p.m. Carried. Next regular board meeting will be Wednesday September 8th at 7:00 p.m. in the Grand View Town Hall.
