

Town Board Meeting
Wednesday October 13,, 2021

Present: Chairman Iverson, Supervisor Ahlvin, Clerk Gunderson, Treasurer Mottram and 8 others. Absent Supervisor Swanson.

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Iverson at 7:00 p.m. Minutes of September 8th read. Motion Ahlvin/Iverson to approve. Carried. Financial Report - Motion Ahlvin/Iverson. Carried.

OLD BUSINESS: Wake Ordinance – see our Jackson Lake Ordinance #040825. Don't feel this really applies to us – No Action.

Roofs – ran short on metal. When it comes in they will be finished.

REPORTS: Road Crew gave Jack a report which he read. They have been installing new culverts, graded roads as needed, loaded big objects at the recycling center, graveled Dybedal Rd., worked on Pole Building site and TRIP and LRIP requests.

The Bayfield County Board Chair and Administrator sent a request to join in on their Comprehensive Plan. Teresa with send a request to Larry Nelson to make sure that our Grand View Comprehensive Plan has been sent to the County as they don't appear to have received it. Will also ask Larry to set up a meeting to address a zoning request we received so that we can act on it at our next meeting.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Steve Wysocki was here to let the board know that the Wysocki's are retiring from leading the fireworks. They would be done through Spielbauer Fireworks Company now. Steve is still willing to help. Some of the hardware they used is for sale so would not be available unless we bought it. This may mean no more large mortars. Will most likely be scaled down. We would have to hire Spielbauer and help would have to be paid (two people were paid last year but only \$220). The same show that we had last year would most likely cost more than \$7,000.00. Washburn and Bayfield both use Spielbauer. Maybe look at sponsors for this? Will want to do some checking so tabled for now.

Jim Wysocki – road is better but needs crown and more gravel. Club Lake Rd is in bad shape – needs gravel and there is a clogged culvert.

Kevin Johnson – dirt bike off-road track on S. Sweden Rd – there have been a few complaints. Ryan Larson property – we can't do anything about riding on their property but when they were tearing up the road he addressed it. Ryan told him that he would keep them off the road. There really isn't anything the Town can do as they are not breaking any laws at this point.

NEW BUSINESS: Jason Swanson has submitted an email stating he needed to resign as he has taken an over-the-road trucking job. This requests needs to be submitted to the clerk in writing. Will look at adding discussion and possible appointment of interim board member to the November agenda.

There will be a 4-towns meeting with Drummond, Cable, Grand View and Namakagon. It is Grand View's turn to host this meeting. Will try to set it up for Wednesday, October 27th at 7:00 p.m.

Work session for budget – will set up meeting on Monday, October 18th at 10:00 a.m. Ambulance budgets are going up – Great Divide to about \$47,000 and Mason to \$16,800. This is about double what we have been paying!

Road Improvement Plan – Mark has been meeting with County to work on LRIP/TRIP. Plan to finish up brushing this year, gravel Dybedal and Old Grade Rd (Dybedal is finished), replace culverts on Road to Nowhere. Tom Garnett asked where Tringle Dr. is on the plans – a culvert needs to be replaced before the rest of the work can be done. Have been meeting with Fishery people to get this replaced. Plan is to replace culvert next summer. Will also have to get the ties out of Taylor lake Boat Landing and fix.

Motion Ahlvin/Iverson to adjourn at 8:05 p.m. Carried. Next regular board meeting will be Wednesday November 10th to follow Budget Hearing and Special meeting to set levy which are at 7:00 p.m. in the Grand View Town Hall.
