

Town Board Meeting
Wednesday November 10,, 2021

Present: Chairman Iverson, Supervisor Ahlvin and Clerk Gunderson and 4 others. Absent Supervisor Swanson and Treasurer Mottram.

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Iverson at 7:20 p.m. Minutes of October 13th read. Motion Ahlvin/Iverson to approve. Carried. Financial Report - Motion Ahlvin/Iverson. Carried.

OLD BUSINESS: Roofs are completed.

REPORTS: Road Crew gave Jack a report which he read – see attached.

4-Towns Meeting – Kelly Peterson from NWRP presented a housing survey report. There have been some short-term rentals problems in Cable and Namakagon. They discussed a proposal to raise permit fees from \$250.00 to \$750.00 and to double room tax fee from 4% to 8%. Discussed ambulance.

Ambulances – Great Divide has about tripled and Mason doubled. Mason is also discussing adding a \$300,000 addition to add sleeping quarters!

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Tom Garnett would like to recognize that tomorrow is Veterans Day and to also recognize the 13 soldiers that died in Afghanistan this year as they were being pulled out. He would like the Board to pass a resolution to this affect. Motion Iverson/Ahlvin to pass resolution recognizing all Town of Grand View Vets. Carried.

NEW BUSINESS: Motion Ahlvin/Iverson to approve Randall Gilbertson zoning requests with addition of access road meets all applicable standards and well, sanitary and building permits are issued prior to any construction. Carried.

Treasurers Bond – Motion Iverson/Ahlvin to pass resolution to bond treasurer for the 2021 tax season to be collected in 2022. Carried

Motion Iverson/Ahlvin to table appointing interim supervisors until we receive a written resignation from Jason. Carried.

Motion Ahlvin/Iverson to adjourn at 7:50 p.m. Carried. Next regular board meeting will be Wednesday December 8th at 7:00 p.m. in the Grand View Town Hall.
