PUBLIC COMMENTS: Mike Oravis asked why our town roads are not plowed when all the other towns are – per Jack the crew plans on going out at 5:00 in the morning.

NEW BUSINESS: 5-year road plan – see attached ‘Town of Grand View Five Year Plan 2023’. Add Blake Ave to 2024 plan. Should look into hiring an Engineer if we are going to try to tap into Federal money. For blacktopping the engineering cost are out-of-pocket but for bridges it is part of the project. Room Tax – Bayfield County is getting into it. Looking at revisions to the Short Term Rental ordinance. The Room tax pays a good portion of what it takes to run the Chamber. We paid in about \$14,000 last year.
