

WE NEED YOUR HELP

The Town of Grand View is being fined by Waste Management for every load of recyclables that contains items of trash. “Unacceptable” items being put in with the recyclables has been a problem for some time, but it has gotten worse and continues to cost the Town money.

When collecting your household recyclables, please note that the following items should NOT be included:

- All food containers that have not been emptied and cleaned out.
- All plastic that does not contain the recycling symbol.
- All Styrofoam
- All plastic bags
- Plastic knives, spoons and forks
- Used paper plates, pizza boxes, etc.
- Bubble wrap
- Packing peanuts
- Plastic food wrap and used aluminum foil
- Coat hangers, toys, drinking straws,
- Mercury bulbs
- Batteries (hearing aid, AAA, AA, etc.)
- Paint cans (both metal and plastic)
- Window glass
- Coffee grounds and food scraps

All recyclables will be inspected in the next couple of weeks. Expect delays. All non-recyclable items found will be placed in the trash bin and the customer will be charged.
