- Printer- Riley with Loffler gave options on printers. Motion Gilbertson/Ahlvin to purchase cannon copier as quoted. Carried
- Gravel Crushing- Doing the federal pit this year is an option. We will not need to bid this out.
- Parking lot posts- Mark got a quote for roughly \$1500 to replace posts in the parking lot. Motion Gilbertson/Ahlvin to replace posts. Carried.
- Dump Truck estimate- Motion Gilbertson/Ahlvin to order dump truck chassis for delivery next fall. Carried.
- Loader Extended Warranty- Motion Gilbertson /Ahlvin to extend loader warranty for 2 years and keep this unit. Iverson- nay. Carried.
- Park purchases quote- Motion Gilbertson/Ahlvin to purchase \$8200 in playground equipment as quoted. Carried.
